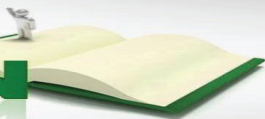

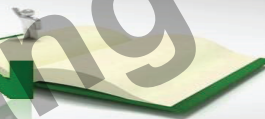

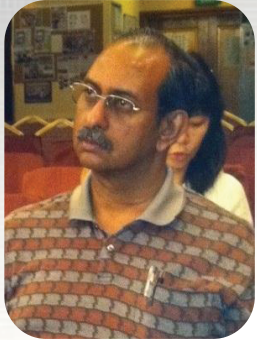

Today's Sermon: Pressing On in Victory

Speaker: Bro Patrick Stephen

Scripture Text: **Philippians 3:12-14** (NIV1984)
Pressing on Toward the Goal

¹² Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already been made perfect, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me.¹³ Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do:

Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, ¹⁴ I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

At different points in our life, we sometimes need to pause to take stock of our lives and ministry. We are also at a vital point today as a church.

The church is formally stretching the boundaries to claim new land. Within this are great moves of faith- trusting God like Caleb to claim a mountain, stretching out tent curtains wider like the prophet Isaiah told Israel.

Let us look more closely at our text to see what we can learn:

1. The apostle Paul, now a prisoner was taking stock of his life. He had no clear indication as to how long he would live. So this was not a one year or a five year workplan. This was a life review.
2. Paul had, earlier in this chapter shared how he had been a zealous Jew saw his salvation based on good works. On the Damascus Road, he found Jesus, and suddenly, all that he had given his life to became worth nothing.
3. Paul now found that what really mattered was his relationship with Jesus, finding reconciliation, forgiveness and moving into a deeper intimacy Jesus.

So HOW does he live the new life?

"Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, ¹⁴ I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus."

vs 13-14

Paul says that there is one thing he does: he presses on toward the goal to which God had called him in Christ. Everything he does was seen in relation to this.

Lets look more closely at this HOW

- a. Paul recognised that despite his years as an apostle, he had not reached there yet- he was still in the race.
- b. Notice that even whilst on this point, Paul also was reminding himself that none of this was really something that he could take credit for. He pressed on because it was Jesus who had taken the initiative to draw Paul to him.
- c. In order to press on, Paul has to forget what was past, both good and bad, so that he could press on.
 - Some people cannot discern the seasons in their lives and move on changes in circumstances, health, relocation etc
 - Churches that suffer because leaders who had been greatly used by God cannot discern the season on their lives and refuse to release
 - Past baggage of failures, hurts etc that we carry

Lesson learnt from the ladder- we must release in order to move on.

- d. Paul says that he strains forward. Its was not about sitting in a riverboat cruising down the river singing Que Sera, sera.

- e. Keep your eye on Jesus

Paul had the right goal. The Prize of the **high calling in Jesus**, or heavenly call of God in Jesus. If you have the wrong goals, you may happily reach it, but find it brings no joy.

Conclusion:

Paul was not in competition with anyone. It was about finishing **his** race. We need to recognise that too. we will all meet after the finishing line. It does not matter who gets there first. But it does matter whether you finish and how u finish.

- a. While you have many practical goals for your life do you have spiritual goals.
- b. Don't forget the story of ladder
- c. Ask God for fire and passion to reach your goal.

The percentage is a generalization of what we retain.
Understanding and Remembering are better when we make notes.

今日讲章： 努力面前得胜

经文：腓 3:12-14

努力面前朝标杆直跑

¹² 这不是说，我已经得着了，已经完全了。我那是竭力追求，或者可以得著基督耶稣所以得著我的。¹³ 弟兄们，我不是以为自己已经得着了，我只有一件事，就是忘记背后努力面前的，¹⁴ 朝著标杆直跑，要得神在基督耶稣里从上面召我来得的奖赏。

在我们生命的不同阶段，有时我们需要停下来检讨自己的生命和事工。作为教会，我们也正处在这重要时刻。

教会通常伸展界限收复新地。要这么做，需要极大的信心 - 信靠神，犹如迦勒收复一座山，如以赛亚先知嘱咐以色列百姓伸展帐棚。

让我们来更深入探讨今日的经文，看看能从中学习什么：

1. 现在的使徒保罗是囚犯，他正在检讨自己的生命。他不清楚自己能活多久。所以，他无法拟定一年或五年计划。这只是他的一个生命检讨。
2. 在这章的前部分，保罗分享他曾是热心的犹太人，以为靠善工能称义。在大马士革的路上，他找着了耶稣，忽然间，他之前视为珍宝的如今竟成粪土。
3. 保罗找着最紧要的，就是与耶稣的关系，就是与耶稣和好，得饶恕，与耶稣更加亲近。

那么，他要如何活出这新生命呢？

“弟兄们，我不是以为自己已经得着了，我只有一件事，就是忘记背后努力面前的，¹⁴ 朝著标杆直跑，要得神在基督耶稣里从上面召我来得的奖赏。” 13-14 节

保罗说，我只有一件事：他朝著标杆直跑，要得神在基督耶稣里从上面召我来得的奖赏。他所作的一切都与这目标相联系。

让我们更深入看看“如何”做到

- a. 保罗认清自己虽为使徒多年，他却还未达到 - 他还在竞赛中
- b. 注意：这时候，保罗也提醒自己没有一项是靠自己的功劳。他努力面前，因为乃是耶稣先吸引保罗。

- c. 要继续面前，保罗必须忘记背后，过去无论是好或坏，这样他才能继续面前。
 - 有些人无法辨清自己生命中的季节，以及境况中，健康上，地点位置，等的持续变动。
 - 教会受苦因为为神大大使用的领袖，无法辨清自己生命中的季节，而拒绝放手。
 - 我们背负着过去失败的包袱，伤痛等

从阶梯学习 - 我们必须放手才能继续前进。

- d. 保罗说他努力面前。这并非乘坐船子在河上自在漂流，高声歌唱 Que Sera, Sera.
- e. 注目仰望耶稣
保罗有正确的目标。要得神在基督耶稣里从上面召我来得的奖赏。若你有错误的目标，你可能达到，却发现它无法带给你喜乐。

总结：

保罗不是与任何人竞赛。这是关乎完成他的赛事。我们也必须认清这点。我们将在终点会面。谁先抵达不是问题。然而，问题是你有没有完成赛事，以及你如何完成。

- a. 你生命拟定了许多实际的目标，其中有没有属灵目标
- b. 别忘了阶梯的故事
- c. 求神赐下火和热心，帮助你达到你的目标

The writer of Hebrews tells of a Sabbath rest for God's people. But assured to those who "run the race with perseverance" - read Hebrews 12:1. The whole book of Hebrews is actually about the superiority of Jesus and what He did for us on the CROSS - His "Once For All Sacrifice". So as we approach Good Friday and Easter Sunday let us remember NOT only the Promised Sabbath but also the reality that it is Christ's Passion - Suffering, Death, Resurrection, that is the key.

希伯来书的作者讲述, 神百姓的安息日, 肯定那些 "存心忍耐, 奔那摆在我们前头的路程" - 阅希伯来书 12:1。正本希伯来书实际上是关于耶稣的至高权柄, 以及他在十架上为我们成就的工 - 他"作了一次性的献祭"。所以, 当耶稣受难节和复活节来临, 让我们不只纪念安息, 也当记得基督火热的心 - 受难, 死亡, 复活, 这是关键。

What He did for us on the CROSS, rising from the dead and is also a kind of Sabbath (Heb SHABAT). We are reminded that SHABAT literally means "To Cease, Interrupt". And that Sabbath is NOT really just about a day of Worship And Rest. Biblically, Sabbath is a Principle, a Way of Living, of TRUSTING GOD and Doing Good.
